

DRESS CODE

Our dress code exists to foster a positive, distraction-free learning environment.

In keeping with this, all Students are expected to dress in a manner appropriate to the spirit of a Torah School.

Students in grades K-8 are expected to maintain the following standards:

Dress code for Kindergarten to Grade 2

BOYS

- ❑ Solid colored light blue or maroon polo shirt.
- ❑ Solid colored navy blue pants or shorts
- ❑ *Tzitzis* and *Kippah* are to be worn at all times
- ❑ No open footwear or “Crocs” are allowed, as it presents a safety hazard
- ❑ **PHA sweatshirt ONLY*******

GIRLS

- ❑ Solid colored light blue or maroon polo shirt.
- ❑ Solid colored navy blue skirt or jumper. Attention should be paid to the length, as it must reach to the mid-knee.
- ❑ No makeup or open footwear or “Crocs” are allowed
- ❑ *Pants may only be worn under skirts only during P.E.*
- ❑ **PHA sweatshirt ONLY*******

Dress code for grades 3–8

BOYS

- ❑ Solid colored light blue or, maroon polo shirt
- ❑ Solid colored navy blue pants
- ❑ *Tzitzis* and *Kippah* are to be worn at all times
- ❑ No open footwear or “Crocs” are allowed, as it presents a safety hazard
- ❑ **PHA sweatshirt ONLY*******

GIRLS

- ❑ Solid colored light blue or maroon polo shirt
- ❑ Solid colored navy blue skirt. Skirts must reach mid-knee length.
- ❑ No makeup is allowed
- ❑ No open footwear or “Crocs” are allowed, as it presents a safety hazard
- ❑ Pants may only be worn under skirts **only during P.E.**
- ❑ **PHA sweatshirt ONLY*******

ALL STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR SWEATSHIRTS SUPPLIED By Educational outfitters with the P.H.A. LOGO ONLY, No other sweatshirt will be allowed!

If your child wears anything other than a PHA sweatshirt it will be confiscated!

Wearing inappropriate Clothing: The student will not be admitted to class until appropriate clothing is brought to school.
